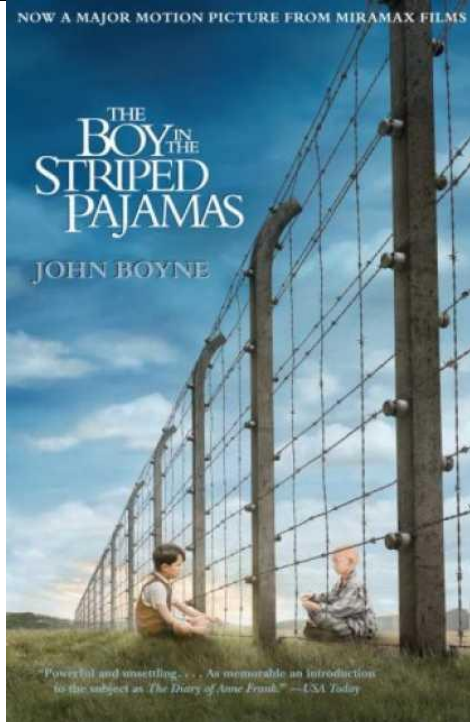

'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe' by CS Lewis

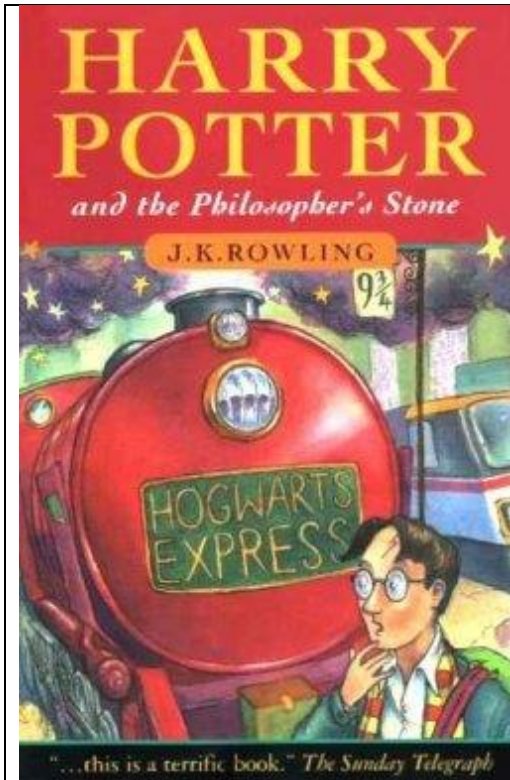
This classic fantasy novel is the first in a series of 7. It features a group of children who stumble into a magical world through an old wardrobe.

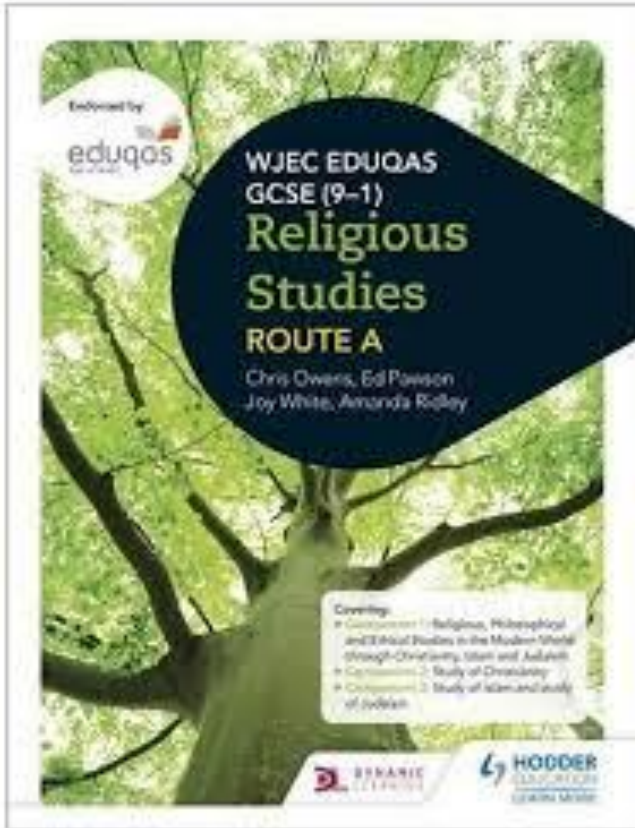
'Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone'

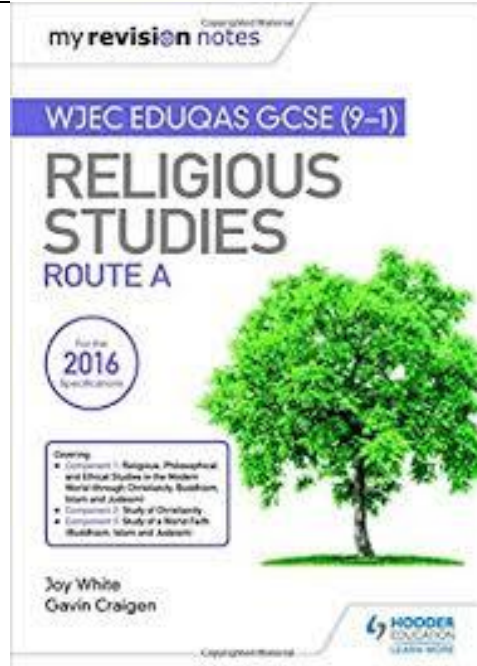


