Google Classroom is designed to help teachers and students communicate and collaborate, manage assignments paperlessly, and stay organized. Google Classroom is part of the Google Apps for Education suite of tools and is only available to Google Apps for Education accounts.

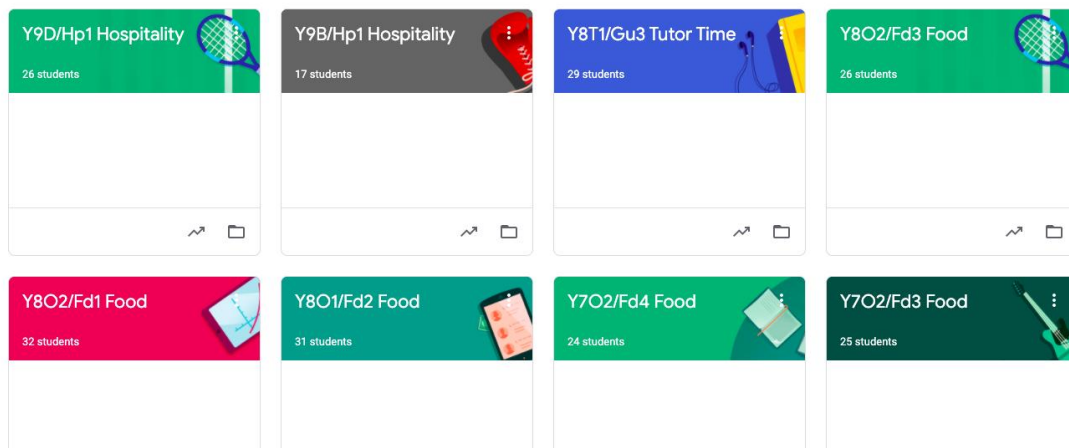
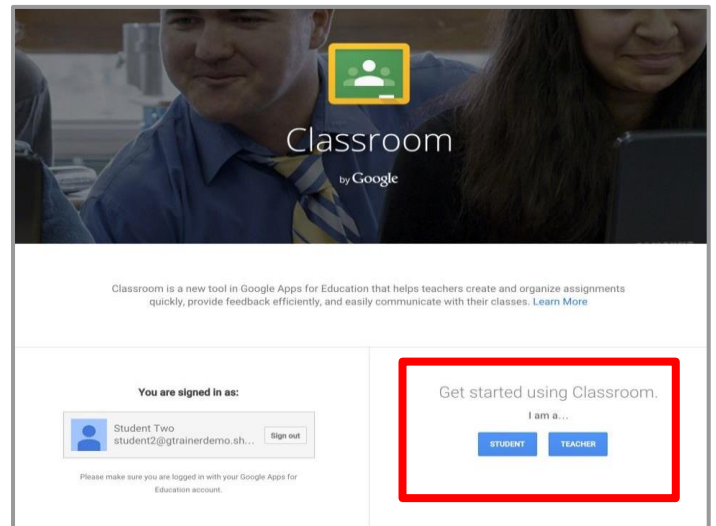
First Login

Go to classroom.google.com and log in with your school email address and password

The first time you arrive at Google Classroom you will see a screen like the one to the right. Scroll down and choose your role as student.

- Student role: Can join classes in Google Classroom.

There are 4 sections to the classroom

Stream **The Stream** is where teachers view and add announcements, assignments, discussion topics, and comments.

Classwork This is where work will be added by your teachers, in the form of assignments, questions, quizzes using google forms or just links to pre-prepared resources

Marks This is the area where you can review what marks or grades you have been given by your teachers.
